Time each guided reading session, keeping it short for younger students in primary grades. Keep guided reading sessions at 15 to 20 minutes each for reading groups in the second grade. Limit guided reading sessions for Kindergarteners and first graders to 15 minutes.

Imagine a teacher. We'll call her Ms. Peregrine. Ms. Peregrine teaches 1st grade and has 5 groups of students for her small group guided reading time. She sees 2 of these groups every day; two of these groups every other day; and the final group 1-2 times per week.

Optional Quick Write ~ Students write 5-6 Fluency Words on white boards (not necessary for grades 3 and up). Do you use small groups to teach reading? Small groups are my absolute hands-down favorite way to teach reading. It is hard for me to individually connect with 24-30 students. The 4-8 students sitting in front of me at my table. Those are students I can reach individually every day. So, this is what our guided reading time looks like. With my below-grade level group, I plan 20 minutes, but my two on-grade level groups get 15 minutes. Not included above is my above-grade-level group - we have moved completely to Chapter Book studies - Frog and Toad, Horrible Harry, Cam Jansen, etc.

Fourth and Fifth grade, have three classes each. Again, they have them divided into three groups: Intensive, Proficient, and Enrichment. The intensive kids do rotations with their teacher, so he meets with 2 small groups per day to work on skills they need (his group is also the smallest so he can really meet their needs).

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
